## ***2009-10 JBT WOMEN'S SERIES***

The following JBT events will feature a separate girls' title match between the two highest 5-game qualifying round totals, regardless of the division you're bowling in:

August 29...	AMF Imperial Lanes, Seattle WA
September 12...	20 <sup>th</sup> Century Lanes, Portland OR
September 13...	Del Rosa Lanes, San Bernardino CA
September 20...	Red Rock Lanes, Las Vegas NV
October 11...	Oasis Lanes, El Paso TX
October 25...	Cactus Bowl, Tucson AZ
November 14...	AMF Deer Valley, Phoenix AZ
December 29...	Cerbat Lanes, Kingman AZ

**Additional dates will be announced through May 2010**

Winners of each title match will be eligible for a Bonus Prize List at the JBT Girls' Invitational, held in the spring of 2010.

### *Additional Rules on the Female Points System & Girls' Invitational:*

1. Each regular season JBT singles event that features the same lane conditions in all divisions will award points to the top five female 5-game scratch pinfall totals, regardless of the division in which the bowler is competing, in the following system: (100, 50, 30, 20, 10), with tied bowlers splitting those points. The high point finisher will be the JBT Female Bowler of the Year. The Girls Invitational will offer triple point values.
2. The Girls' Invitational will be open to any female who earns a top-5 female finish, and thus points, in the manner described above, in the 09-10 season. Details on the Invitational format, location, and prize lists will be released as soon as possible.
3. At Women's Series events, the Women's Series title match will take place as soon as both finalists are eliminated from the regular event, pending lane availability. If one or both of the finalists is unable to bowl the title match (or one can't wait for the other to be eliminated), the next highest qualifier will bowl the title match, thus having a chance to earn the Invitational bonus prize list spot, but will not move up in that event's female points results. The ability for a bowler to accept scholarships or not (due to NCAA restrictions) does not affect points, Invite bonus spots, or any other facet of the Women's Series competition.
4. Ties for the top or second spot in the Women's Series title match will be broken by highest game throughout the 5-game qualifying round.
