



2009-10 CONDUCT VIOLATION POLICIES

It is the goal of JBT to run professional-style events for juniors of all ages and averages. Thus, we expect our bowlers to act as the young professionals we hope they look to be seen as.

First, we recognize that you are KIDS! Positive enthusiasm that does not negatively impact the tournament will NEVER be punished. If we have a problem with your enthusiasm, we'll let you know. It's a bowling tournament, not a library!

That said, the following are guidelines for potential violations of the JBT behavior rules:

Audible curse (minor):	5 points OR pins
Audible curse:	10 points OR pins OR disqualification
Audible curse (major):	25 points OR pins OR disqualification and/or suspension
Abuse of center equipment:	25 points OR pins OR disqualification
Unsigned scorecard:	10 points OR pins
Scorecard error (uncorrected):	5 points OR pins per error
Conduct unbecoming a JBT member:	Disqualification subject to director's discretion.
Cheating of any kind:	Disqualification and suspension

The above are guidelines and may be increased or decreased at ANY time by ANY JBT Official. In general, taking pins away from your actual score is seen as worse by the kids than point fines, and will be used for worse and/or repeat offenses. If you don't want to find out, don't test us!

It is NOT the goal of JBT to turn things into a discipline "witch hunt"- 99% of the time, things are great anyway. We do NOT want to hear from parents or bowlers "he said this, kick him out". Officials are constantly walking around- sooner or later, violators will be caught. However, we DO want you to tell us, "you might want to keep an eye on this guy or gal"... that is very helpful.

All eyes are on us here at JBT, and we intend to impress. It is harder every day to get big tournaments scheduled, and we want our bowling centers to continue to be thrilled to host us.
