

09-10 ENTRY FEE AND OPTIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS EXPLANATION:

BASIC ENTRY FEE (\$33, \$31 if prepaid)- For your basic entry fee, you are eligible to receive our plaques and trophies, as well as JBT points. Points qualify you for our season-ending Invationals and Touring Players' Championship, as well as a number of other bonuses and awards throughout the season. There's big, big money in the year-end events, so there's a big reason to earn those points!

Also included in your basic entry fee are:

HIGH GAMES- Competition is separated into scratch and handicap divisions. The highest five games of the tournament, with handicap in the handicap divisions, will receive JBT points in the conference in which the event is listed in the amounts of 25-20-15-10-5. Bowlers can win multiple awards.

50 CLEAN- Any bowler may enter. If you complete the 5-game qualifying round (or the first 5 games of longer rounds) without an open frame, you will be entered free into the 50 Clean Finals, which will be contested at the 2010 TPC. The 50 Clean Finals winner earns a guaranteed minimum \$300 scholarship.

The following programs are optional, meaning you are not eligible to receive these prizes unless you enter into them:

POSITION SCHOLARSHIP (\$7)- This prize is based on your final standings in today's event. For example, if you finish first today AND you enter this program, you would win the top scholarship prize. If you finish second today AND enter this optional, BUT the person who finished ahead of you did not enter this optional, you would still get the top prize in this event. Competition is separated between scratch and handicap. 1 out of 6 entrants will receive a prize, and first prize is a guaranteed minimum \$200.

BRACKETS (\$2 each)- Brackets are randomly drawn head to head matches against other bowlers held simultaneously with the regular tournament. Competition takes place during games 2-4 of the qualifying round. For every bracket you sign up for, you randomly draw a match against another bowler in your division during game two. If you beat your opponent, you advance and bowl during game 3 against another opponent who also won their first match. This continues until 2 bowlers are left in each bracket. They will play each other in game 4, with the winner of each bracket receiving a \$15 scholarship prize. **More info on brackets is available at all JBT events.**

POWERBOWL TICKETS AND/OR EBONITE BALL RAFFLE TICKETS are on sale throughout the 5-game qualifying round. Ebonite bowling balls are given away at most JBT events. PowerBowl is a chance for any bowler to get a huge scholarship bonus- the tickets you buy are for both drawings.

Remember, you must be entered in an optional in order to win prizes in that optional. You can enter different optionals at each event you bowl. You must enter these optionals before the tournament begins.

Making the scholarship programs optional and separate gives you the most flexibility on what you'd like to get out of your JBT experience. We hope you enjoy!
